snake eyes [**sneyk** -ahyz]: A spare leave where the 7 and 10 pin are still standing; also known as the 7-10 Split, fence posts, bed posts, mule ears and goal posts.

“Anchor” Lane Sponsor

an•chor [**ang**-ker]: Last player to roll in competition. Usually the best player: i.e., the bowler most likely to get a strike.

Now you might ask “What is TAC and how does it affect me?” TAC is a political action organization that promotes the interest of registered architects in Texas by raising funds for campaign contributions, to have our voices heard in the legislative process.
